<b>Peach, Red Haven</b> - Self-fertile, freestone, easy to grow all-purpose peach for fresh eating, canning or freezing. Blooms late to avoid spring frosts. A favorite.							4-5 ft.	\$25 ea./\$45 pr		
<b>Nectarine, Firebright</b> – Large yellow with red blush fruit. Flesh is yellow, firm, and has excellent flavor. The tree is vigorous and productive. Semi-Cling. Ripens late July/early August. Self-fruitful, you do not need a pollinator.							4-5 ft.	\$25 ea./\$45 pr		
<b>Honeycrisp Apple</b> - 'Royal Red' The crunch, texture, and excellent storage life. This late midseason apple is produced on a good winter hardy tree. ORDER EARLY, these go fast.							4-5 ft.	\$25 ea./\$45 pr		
<b>Granny Smith</b> – Med to large green apple with aromatic, sweet, with a firm, crisp bite. Stores well and is good for fresh eating, baking, and cooking. Typically ripens in August/September. Can be pollinated with fuji.							4-5 ft.	\$25 ea./\$45 pr		
<b>Fuji, Aztec</b> – You will be rewarded with a sweet flavor and abundance of juice along with the satisfying crunch of its firm texture. Thick skin, medium to large size apple.							4-5 ft.	\$25 ea./\$45 pr

Chestnut, Chinese, <i>Castanea mollissima</i> , 2-3', grows 40-60 ft., full sun, blight resistant and drought tolerant. Needs moderately acid soil. Plant in pairs or groups for pollination. \$7 each or 3/\$18			
Red Raspberry, 'Latham' – A reliable, sweet, firm berry. Excellent for fresh, freezing, jams and jellies. \$7 each or 3/\$18			
Strawberry, Jewel – Junebearing. Best variety for home gardening. Large, firm, excellent color and quality. bundle of 12/\$12, bundle of 25/\$23			
Strawberry, Ozark Beauty – Everbearing. High yields of very sweet fruit. Large berries ideal for desserts, jams. bundle of 12/\$12, bundle of 25/\$23			
Fern, Cinnamon – Up to 6 ft. tall. Part sun/shade. Does not spread. \$7 each or 3/\$18			
Fern, Maidenhair – 2-3 ft. tall. Prefers moist soil, but adapts to a variety of conditions. \$7 each or 3/\$18			
Fern, Royal – 2-3 ft. tall. Part/full shade. Prefers moist soil, but adapts to a variety of conditions. \$7 ea or 3/\$18
