<b>Thimbleberry Raspberry</b> – A 5-6'tall, red Michigan native, a sweet, juicy berry can be eaten fresh & used for jams. White flowers appear in early spring; fruits are harvested in late July. 2.5" container \$4.50 each, \$12/3			
<b>Wonderful Pine Strawberry</b> – White fruit, sweet & delicious, good size. \$2.50 each, \$6.50/3, \$10/5, \$18.00/10			
<b>Little Crisp Blueberry</b> – Michigan native wild lowbush. Sweet, small, lite blue fruits. A very adaptable plant grows in a wide variety of soil types. Use as an edible 8-10" ground cover. \$7.50 each, \$21/3, \$32.50/5, \$58/10
